About EDItEUR

- a not-for-profit membership organisation
- develops, supports and promotes metadata and identification standards for the global book, e-book, audio and serials supply chains
 - best known for ONIX, *Thema* and EDItX, but also manages ISNI International Agency
- acknowledged centre of expertise on standards and metadata for the industry
- based in London, but a global membership of publishers, distributors, wholesalers, retailers, subscription agents, libraries, system vendors, rights organizations and trade associations

ONIX 3.1 is not new...

- it is a continuation of more than a decade of incremental development of ONIX 3.0, which led up to version 3.0.8
- in most respects, ONIX 3.1 could have been called ONIX 3.0.9
- new numbering reflects *removal* of a handful of data fields, and consequent loss of a little backwards compatibility
- EDItEUR standards are frequently updated to meet new requirements
 - the latest revision is now 3.1.2 – prompted by EU legislation
 - EDItEUR and its members monitor the supply chain for new issues, or additional metadata that can improve discoverability and sales, which can be incorporated into *future* revisions

ONIX provides...

- a robust, standardised, widely-accepted data file format for describing books of all types, including e-books and digital audiobooks
 - bibliographic details
 - marketing collateral
 - commercial arrangements
- with global applicability – not just Europe and North America
 - multi-language, multi-currency *etc*
 - a shared lexicon for clear international communication
- and independent governance, freely usable by all

- support for Open Access publishing
 - at a *per-chapter* level, if necessary
 - licenses, funders, links to repositories etc – <https://tinyurl.com/2vn8yr83>
- support for persistent identifiers for scholars, educational and research institutions
 - most particularly ORCID, ISNI, ROR to ensure correct academic credit
- support for responsible declarations of AI use in content creation
 - AI voices in audiobooks, AI translations, AI illustration assistance
- ‘block 8’ – product setup for print-on-demand
 - manufacturing details

- scholarly presses are part of a global supply chain for books – and an equally global metadata supply chain
- the ‘language’ of that metadata supply chain is ONIX
- the international nature of the standard is critical
- the standard levels the field for smaller presses, smaller languages and smaller markets, increasing the visibility of your books around the world
- ONIX supports the business needs of a wide range of publishing, including scholarly publishers. It encourages consistency in internal workflows, and can help broaden a publisher’s customer base and grow revenues
